Hand Tree (Kids)

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- Cardstock
- Paper Towel Roll
- Glue Stick
- Tape
- Paper Plate
- Green Paint


INSTRUCTIONS

1. First, paint your paper plate green and set aside to dry.



2. Cut slits in the bottom of the paper towel roll and tape to your paper plate.





3. Then trace your hand and arm on the brown cardstock so that the "trunk" of the tree is long enough to cover the paper towel roll.



4. Glue your handprint "trunk" to your paper towel roll.



5. Now trace regular handprints with your other color cardstock. You'll need 5 handprints (1 for each finger) so you can choose which colors get traced twice. We did orange, red, yellow, orange, and red.



6. Now you can glue your handprints to your tree! Add one to each finger.



7. To cover the tape at the bottom, add some pinecones and sticks for decoration. Glue these down if you want them to be permanent. You

may need to use hot glue if you want them to stay permanently. Have adults do this part or use cold hot glue that is rated safe for kids.
